ORDER

A new Medical Insurance Scheme has been introduced in Kerala Water Authority with effect from 16.04.2014 vide read above. Insurance coverage is only applicable for the In-patient treatment of employees and dependents. It was also decided that 50% of the Pay + DA will be sanctioned to meet the expenses in connection with the Out-patient treatment in two installments in a calendar year. In the circumstances sanction is hereby accorded to draw and disburse 50% of the Pay + DA as admissible to the employees of Kerala Water Authority as OP Claim of medical treatment in two installments @ 25% + 25%, which is incurred for the employees and their dependents during the calendar year 2017. As per vide ref (3), rule (3) states that "The Claims for reimbursement of medical expenditure shall be made in the form appended to these rules and shall be accompanied by vouchers countersigned by the authorised medical attendant. In cases where the vouchers are not countersigned, the vouchers shall be accompanied by the prescription of the medical attendant." Necessary funds for meeting this claim will be allotted from this office subject to availability. Controlling Officers are directed to disburse the claim only after getting the necessary funds for the purpose from Head Office. Funds will be allotted only after getting the details from the Controlling Officer.



Kerala Water Authority has introduced Medical Insurance Scheme to employee of Kerala Water Authority as per reference 3rd cited. Insurance coverage is only applicable for the inpatient treatment of employees and dependants. Hence, it is decided that 50% of the Pay + DA will be sanctioned to meet the expense in connection with outpatient treatment as per the existing Medical Re-imburement Claim Rule in force vide reference 2nd cited.

Hence you are directed to reimburse the medical claim of the incumbents after verifying the genuinity of the same. "The claims for reimbursement of medical expenditure shall be made in the form appended to these rules and shall be accompanied by vouchers countersigned by the authorised medical attendant. In case where the vouchers are not countersigned the voucher shall be accompanied by the prescription of the medical attendant"

In the case of Ayurveda and Homoeopathic treatment the Medical Bill shall be preferably by the Government Institution.
