PREPARATION OF STATEMENT OF FACTS

Points to be noted.

- Give a brief history of the case in the beginning.
- Answer para by para and ground by ground without omissions.
- Every averments and allegations must be answered.
- Cross reference of paras can be made.

- Costs to be claimed in relevant cases particularly in frivolous and vexatious litigations.
- All the exhibits stated in the affidavit are to be enclosed with the sof.
- Ensure filing of sof in time since delay will affect adversely.
- Pursue the case with Standing Counsel.

- Legal questions will be answered by Legal Section.
- If there is no appeal comply with the order /Judgment in time.
- In contempt case separate sof is to be given.
- If revised sof is sought, that should be furnished urgently.

 Name and the official/personal number of the officer concerned is to be mentioned in the sof.

 The following undertaking shall be specified; the above facts are true to the best of my knowledge and belief.
