


PREPARATION OF STATEMENT OF FACTS IN LOWER COURT CASES

All the cases upto the District court and Session court are lower court cases such as :

- OS (Original Suit)
- AS (Appeal Suit)
- LAR (Land Acquisition Report)

Cases in different Forums and Commissions are also considered as lower court cases.

- CDRC (Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission)
- Lok Ayuktha Cases
- Permanent Lok Adalath cases
- Human Rights Commission cases
- Industrial Tribunal cases, etc



Civil cases are redressed in Munsiff courts and District courts and administration of criminal justice is carried out through Magistrate court and Session court


Copy of the petition/complaint shall be forwarded to the Standing Counsel as soon as the notice is received.

Points to be considered while preparing statement of facts

- i. Give a brief history of the case in the beginning.
- ii. Read the petitions carefully and answer paragraph by paragraph and ground by ground.
- iii. All the averments and allegations must be answered.
- iv. Cost should be claimed in fit cases.

Follow up action

- i. Pursue the matter of cases with the Standing Counsel
- ii. If there is an interim stay against KWA, get it vacated.
- iii. Get copy of judgment in time. Delay may affect the right to appeal.

- iv. Decree amount should be deposited in time to avoid additional payment by way of interest etc.
 - v. Execution of decree or order favourable to KWA must be ensured and implemented.

We must be cautious and make timely inquiries and communications with Standing Counsels to protect the interest of KWA

Structure of Courts
