ORDER

In connection with the Golden Jubilee of Indian Independence, Government vide reference read first above order the reappointment of all physically handicapped provisional employees who were engaged in public service through the various Employment exchanges under rule 9(a) (i) of KS & SR, 1958 at any time during the period from 1.1.1997 to 31.12.1997 on a purely provisional basis until further orders. Subsequently, government vide its order read second above extended the above benefit to physically handicapped provisional employees who were engaged in public service from 1.1.98 to 14.8.1998.

Kerala Water Authority, in consultation with Government, decided to extend the benefit of the above Government orders to Kerala Water Authority and accordingly issued orders reappointing those physically handicapped provisional employees who were in the service of Kerala Water Authority during period from 1.1.1997 to 14.8.1998. The above decision was taken by the "authority" vide its resolution read fourth above which inter alia laid down the condition that these employees will be regularized in service only after obtaining the validity of the Medical certificates produced by them.

In pursuance to the above decision of the authority, the regional Chief Engineers were directed to forward the relevant details including copies of Medical Certificates submitted by these employees. Subsequently the copies of Medical Certificates received through the Regional Chief Engineers were

In deference to the request of Kerala Water Authority, the Director Health Services summoned these employees before the State Standing Disability Assessment Board on 22nd, 23rd and 24th of September 2003 for medical examination and forwarded a comprehensive report to this office vide reference read fifth above. Altogether 93 employees were found to be having physical disability of 40% and above 40%. As such, these 93 employees became eligible for regularization on the basis of the government order read third above as well as the resolution of the Authority read fourth above.

In the above circumstance, the provisional service of the above said 93 physically handicapped employees are regularized with effect from the date mentioned against their respective names in the annexure appended with this order. The respective controlling officers should enter the relevant facts in the service Book of the incumbents without fail.

ORDER

The question of regularising the services of the physically handicapped provisional (temporary) employees who were engaged in service during the 'SAARC year of the handicapped' has been engaging the attention of the Government for some time past. Pending final decision and orders in the matter, the following instructions were issued in the circular read as 1st paper above.

"(i) The physically handicapped provisional (temporary) employees who were engaged in Public Service through the Employment Exchanges under Rule 9 (a) (1) of the Kerala State and Subordinate service Rules, 1958 during the period from 1.1.93 to 31.7.94 and who are still continuing in service will be retained in service on a purely provisional basis, until further orders.

(ii) The Physically handicapped provisional (Temporary) employees who were engaged in Public Service through the Employment Exchange under Rule 9 (a) (i) of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958 during the period from 1.1.93 to 31.7.94 and ousted from service (on completion of 180 days of service or on account of expiry of ~~vacancy~~ vacancies consequent on joining duty of nominees of P.S.C or for such other reasons) will be reappointed on a purely provisional basis and allowed to continue until further orders.

(iii) The reappointment of such retrenched physically handicapped persons mentioned above will be in the same Department and against the same category of post.

(iv) In case such retrenched person as mentioned above had worked in more than one Department during the period from 1.1.93 to 31.7.94, the reappointment will be in the Department where he had worked last.

2. The question of regularisation of the services of the physically handicapped provisional employees covered by the circular read above was examined by Government in consultation with the Kerala Public Service Commission. The Kerala Public Service Commission vide their letters read as 2nd paper above have declined to agree to the proposal.

3. Government have carefully considered the views expressed by the Public Service Commission in the matter. The services of the physically handicapped provisional employees who were in service during the 'International year of the Disabled,' i.e. in 1981, were regularised in the past. It was, therefore, felt that it is only appropriate to extend a similar treatment to the physically handicapped provisional employees in connection with the SAARC year of the Physically handicapped also. Having examined all the relevant aspects in a humanitarian angle, Government are pleased to issue the following orders overruling the advice of the Public Service Commission.

(i) The services of the physically handicapped provisional employees covered by the circular read above will be regularised with effect from the date of this order or from the date on which the physically handicapped rejoined/ rejoin duty consequent on reappointment, whichever is later.

~~(ii) Such regularisation shall be in the same category of post and in the same Department where the physically handicapped provisional employees were allowed to continue or reappointed.~~

(ii) Such regularisation shall be in the same category of post and in the same Department where the physically handicapped provisional employees were allowed to continue or reappointed.

(iii) Candidate, if any, advised by the Public Service Commission on the date of regularisation of the services of the physically handicapped provisional employees will be declared as their seniors.

(iv) The inter-se-seniority of the physically handicapped provisional employees will be fixed with reference to length of service in the same Department and in the same category of post.

4. Sanction is also accorded for the creation of supernumerary posts for accommodating the physically handicapped provisional employees covered by the circular read above or the Public Service Commission nominees advised to the posts held by such physically handicapped, in the absence of regular vacancies. Provided that such supernumerary posts created temporarily will be absorbed in future and arising vacancies and provided further that, if more than one person worked in one post and if the Public Service Commission had advised another candidate to the same post, only the first provisional handicapped candidate who had manned the post in the said period mentioned in this G.O and the Public Service Commission advised candidate need be given regular appointment and given the benefit of supernumerary post (Restricting the creation of supernumerary post to one against one vacancy).

5. The question as to whether the services of the physically handicapped employees who have put in similar provisional services in Public Sector Undertakings, Local Bodies and autonomous bodies during the period from 1.1.93 to 31.7.94 should be regularised or not can be decided by these bodies themselves taking into consideration the interest of the organisations, and to that extent permissive sanction is also granted.

O R D E R

Government vide the reference read as first paper above had issued instructions to retain the physically handicapped provisional employees who were in service during the period from 1-1-'93 to 31-7-'94 on a purely provisional basis until further orders. Kerala Water Authority has taken up the matter with Government for clarification as to whether the circular dtd: 22-10-'94 is applicable to KWA also. Government vide the order cited as second paper above ordered to consider the question of regularisation of similarly placed provisional employees in this organisation. As such the matter was placed before the Authority for decision and Authority has decided to reinstate/regularise these candidates subject to eligibility vide resolution cited above.

As per the details collected from the subordinate officers the number of physically handicapped provisional employees who were in the service of Kerala Water Authority between 1-1-'93 to 31-7-'94 comes to 154. Out of this the details in respect of two persons namely Sebastian P.S. and Subran A.P (P.H.Division Aluva) has not been received in the prescribed proforma. The question of reinstatement/regularisation of these persons can be decided only on getting the proforma from the concerned officers. One operator is unqualified and 8 others are working in other organisations/Departments

after leaving from KWA. Thus the KWA has to regularise 143 provisional employees who come under the purview of the references read as first and second paper above. O R D E R

Government vide the reference read as 1st paper above, in connection with the Golden Jubilee of India's Independence, had ordered to retain the physically handicapped provisional (temporary) employees who were engaged in public service through the Employment Exchanges under Rule 9(a) (i) of the K.S. & SSR at any time during the period from 1-1-97 to 31-12-97 and are still continuing in service on a purely provisional basis until further orders. Government had also ordered to re-appoint the physically handicapped provisional (temporary) employees who were engaged in public service through Employment Exchanges under Rule 9(a) (i) of the KS & SSR during the above period and ousted from service on completion of 180 days of service or on expiry of vacancies consequent on joining of P.S.C. hands or for other reasons on a purely provisional basis and allowed to continue until further orders. The re-appointment of retrenched persons mentioned above will be in the same Department and against the ^{same} category of posts. The re-appointment will be in the Department where the incumbent had worked last if he/she had worked in more than one Department during the above period.

Since the above Government Order is intended to the PH Provisional hands worked in Government Departments, the matter was placed before the Kerala Water Authority to take a decision whether the said Government Order can be made applicable to K.W.A. also & the KWA vide the reference read as second paper above resolved to recommend the issue to Government. As such the matter was taken up with Government and Government vide Lr.No:2882/B3/99/Ir.D dtd. 23-6-99 informed that the Government Order read as first paper above

Meanwhile, Government vide the reference read as third paper above ordered that the benefit granted to PH Persons as per the G.O. first cited be extended to the PH employees who were in service during the period from 1-1-98 to 14-8-98 also subject to the same conditions specified therein. Since the G.O. read as third paper will also be applicable to K.W.A. as the same was ordered in continuation to the G.O. first cited.

Accordingly the details of PH provisional employees who were in the service of Kerala Water Authority during the period from 1-1-97 to 14-8-98 received through the concerned Chief Engineers were placed before the K.W.A. for consideration for re-appointment on a purely provisional basis as ordered by Government. The Kerala Water Authority vide the reference read as fourth paper above resolved to reinstate the physically handicapped provisional hands worked in Kerala Water Authority during the period from 1-1-97 to 14-8-98 whose details have been received through the concerned Chief Engineers with due recommendation, subject to the condition that they should appear before the standing medical board attached to the General Hospital, Trivandrum for ascertaining the validity of the medical certificates produced by them at the time of appointment, before regularisation of their provisional appointment.

In the above circumstances the undermentioned persons (list appended to this order) are re-appointed in the KWA in the category and allotted to the region/Office noted against their name, on a purely provisional basis until further orders, on the condition that they should appear before the standing Medical Board attached to the General Hospital, Trivandrum for medical examination and produce report of the same, before regularisation of their Provisional appointment in view of this order. The incumbents should produce documents proving their Educational Qualification, Date of Birth, handicapedness etc. at the time of joining duty and also submit the enclosed proforma duly filled up.



ORDER

Government vide reference read first and second ordered the reappointment of all physically handicapped provisional employees engaged in Public service through Employment Exchange under Rule 9(a) (i) of KS&SSR at any time during the period from 1.1.1997 to 14.08.1998 on a purely provisional basis until further orders. Consequent to the above, Kerala Water Authority vide reference read fifth above issued reappointment orders to all eligible employees including one Shri.Prakasan Paremmal who was engaged through Employment exchange as Bacteriologist in Quality Control Division, Kozhikkode. In

pursuance too the above order, Shri.Prakasan Paremmal rejoined duty as Bacteriologist on 13.10.1999. Subsequently, Chief Engineer, IPD informed this office that Shri.Prakasan Paremmal is unqualified to hold the post of Bacteriologist in Kerala Water authority. In view of the above fact, direction was given to Chief Engineer, IPD to terminate his service immediately. However, the incumbent obtained a stay order against his termination and continued in service on the strength of the same. Subsequently, when the stay order was vacated by the Honourable High Court, the Executive Engineer terminated his service with effect from 27.04.2000. Aggrieved by this action, Shri.Prakasan Paremmal filed Writ Appeal 519/2000 before the Honourable High Court. While disposing of the Writ Appeal, the Honourable High Court directed Kerala Water Authority to engage the petitioner as Lower Division Clerk pending orders from Government of Kerala. In conformity with the above direction, Kerala Water Authority vide reference read eight above, appointed Shri.Prakasan Parammal as L.D.Clerk and he joined duty on 18.04.2002.

In the meantime, Government vide reference read third above ordered the regularisation of all the physically handicapped provisional employees reappointed in connection with the Golden Jubilee of Indian Independence. Accordingly, action was initiated to regularise all such employees except Shri.Prakasan Paremmal whose case was pending before Government. Subsequently, Government vide reference read tenth above, directed Kerala Water Authority to regularise the service of Shri.Prakasan Paremmal as Lower Division Clerk in consultation with Kerala Public Service Commission.

In pursuance to the above direction, the matter was taken up with Kerala Public Service Commission and subsequently, Kerala Public Service Commission vide reference read eleventh above gave its concurrence to regularise Shri.Prakasan Paremmal as Lower Division Clerk in Kerala Water Authority.

While agreeing to regularise the service of the physically handicapped provisional employees, the Board of authority vide resolution read fourth above

had inter alia laid down the condition that these employees will be regularised in service only after the Director of Health Services confirms the validity of the medical certificates produced by them as proof of their disability. In conformity with the above, Shri.Prakasan Paremmal was summoned before the State Standing disability Assessment Board constituted under the Director of Health Services for medical examination. Later on, the Director of Health Services vide reference read twelfth above confirmed that Shri.Prakasan Paremmal is Orthopaedically handicapped to the extend of 50%.

In the above circumstance, Shri.Prakasan Paremmal is hereby regularised in the service of Kerala Water Authority as Lower Division, Clerk with effect from 24.04.2004 ie, the date on which Kerala Public Service Commission concurred.



Subsequently, Government vide its order read second above extended the above benefit to physically handicapped provisional employees who were engaged in public service from 01.11.1998 to 14.08.1998.

In pursuance to the above orders, Kerala Water Authority reappointed 96 physically handicapped provisional employees who were engaged during the period from 01.01.1997 to 14.08.98. The decision to reappoint these employees was taken by the Board of Kerala Water Authority vide its resolution read fourth above which inter alia laid down the condition that these employees will be regularized in service only after ascertaining the validity of the medical certificate produced by them. In conformity with the above resolution, the DHS was requested by this office to summon these employees before the SSDAB for medical examination. Out of the 96 provisional employees, 93 appeared before the Board and proved their disability and hence their service was regularized vide proceedings read fifth above. However, since three employees, viz, Shri.N.Libinson, Smt.E.J. Mary and Shri.K.L.Francis failed to appear before the SSDA Board, their service was not regularized. Subsequently a decision was taken to give them one more chance and accordingly they were once

against summoned before the SSDA Board by the DHS on 08.03.2004. After examining them, the SSDA Board has certified their disability in percentage terms as follows.

1. Shri.N.Libinson - 40%
2. Smt.E.J. Mary - 40%
3. Shri.K.L.Francis - 50%

As such, these employees are eligible for regularization. In the above circumstance, the provisional service of these three employees are hereby regularized with effect from the dates shown against their respective names in the table given below. The respective controlling officers should enter the relevant facts in the Service Books of the incumbents without fail.

ORDER

The question of regularising the services of the physically handicapped provisional (temporary) employees who were engaged in Government service during the period from 15/8/98 to 15/8/99 has been engaging the attention of the Government.

2) The Kerala Public Service Commission has advised that regularisation of provisionally appointed handicapped persons is a policy matter of Government and that they have no objection in the matter but the regularisation may be effected in vacancies other than those reported to the Commission.

3) The Director of Social Welfare Department as per his letter read as second paper above has forwarded a list of physically handicapped persons who have completed 179 days of provisional service during the period from 15/8/1998 to 15/8/1999.

4) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to regularise the provisional service of those physically handicapped persons who have completed 179 days of provisional service by appointment through Employment Exchanges under Rule 9(a)(1) of the Kerala Subordinate Service Rules 1958, during the period from 15/8/98 to 15/8/99. Sanction is accorded for creating supernumerary posts for reappointment/regularisation of these provisional hands and order that the physically handicapped persons mentioned in appendix-I to this Government Order will be reappointed and regularised based on the following conditions.

- i) The physically handicapped (temporary) employees who were engaged in public services through Employment Exchange under Rule 9 of (a) (i) K.S.S.R. during the period from 15/8/98 to 15/8/99, for 179 days will be reappointed in service.
- ii) The reappointment of the retrenched persons will be in the same department and against the same category of posts.
- iii) The physically handicapped persons thus reappointed will be regularised with effect from the date of their rejoining duty.

- iv) Candidates if any advised by the Kerala Public Service Commission on the date of regularisation of the services of the physically handicapped provisional employees will be declared as their seniors.

ORDER

Government have issued orders to regularize the provisional service of physically handicapped employees appointed through the Employment Exchange between 15.08.1998 to 15.08.1999, who have completed 179 days within this period vide Government Order read as first above. In view of the said Government Order the Kerala Water Authority had reinstated 15 incumbents.

Government have extended the benefits ordered in the Government Order first cited to all physically handicapped employees appointed through Employment Exchange between the period from 15.08.1998 to 15.08.1999 as per Rule 9(a)(i) of KS&SSR in the Public Sector Undertakings, local bodies, Co-operative Department, various Boards and Corporations etc. vide Government Order read as third above. (The employees will be reinstated in the same category of posts reserved for physically handicapped employees and they will be regularised with effect from the date of rejoining duty).

Based on this Government Order, Sri.S.Biju and Sri.P.Hariharan have filed WP(C)No.6802/07 before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala for reinstatement and the Court in its judgment dated, 20.03.2007 have declared that the petitioners are entitled to be reinstated and to be regularised in service. As per this judgment Government have directed the Kerala Water Authority to reinstate them vide Government Order read as fourth above and as such they were reinstated in the Kerala Water Authority vide this office proceedings of No. dated, 15.10.2007 and it has been ratified by Resolution No.7537 of the 302nd meeting of the Kerala Water Authority held on 31.10.2007.

Government have temporarily stopped all reinstatement process vide reference 5th cited, based on the request of the Advocate General. But the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala in its judgment in WP(C) No.37281/07 has allowed Government to continue the process of reinstatement of physically handicapped provisional employees.

As per GO (P)No.43/2007/SWD dated, 9.08.2007, Government further modified the conditions so as to get maximum benefit to the retrenched physically handicapped personnel. The significant aspects in the Government Order are as follows;

1. Government relaxed the condition for completion of 179 days service during the relevant period, considering the grievances of the over aged retrenched persons who had then not completed 179 days of service and their remote chance to re-enter in Government service due to overage. (Para 2 of GO dated, 09.03.2007).
2. Personnel appointed temporarily through Employment Exchange in Government Service, Public Sector Undertaking, Co-operative Societies etc. under Rule 9(a) 1 of KSSR during the period from 15.08.1998 to 15.08.1999 and not reinstated so far are eligible for re-employment. (Para 4 of GO dated, 09.03.2007).
3. Posts reserved for physically handicapped or posts remaining as unfilled as back log will be adjusted for their re-employment. If there is no existing vacancy, they should be reinstated in the first arising vacancies (Para 5 of GO dated, 09.03.2007).
4. Those who are eligible for reinstatement should have to submit application through District Employment Officer with all certificates within two weeks from 09.08.2007 (Date of GO) and eligible hands list should be submitted to the Secretary, Social Welfare Department. Applications should not be submitted direct to Government. etc. (Para 6 of GO dated, 09.03.2007).

The Government Order dated, 09.08.2007 is applicable to Kerala Water Authority also since the conditions laid down in the previous Government Order had adversely affected the re-instatement of physically handicapped similar persons mentioned in the list enclosed.

Therefore the matter has been placed in the Kerala Water Authority Board for a decision to reinstate 17 numbers physically handicapped retrenched personnel who had worked during the period from 15.08.1998 to 15.08.1999 in the respective categories noted against their names, in relaxation of age (in case they are over aged) and also in relaxation of the specific conditions mentioned in Para 6 of the Government Order dated, 09.08.2007, ie, application routing through Employment Exchange etc.

Details have been collected from the subordinate offices in the prescribed proforma. After proper verification, it is noticed that incumbents deserved all the rules stipulated in the Government Order referred above and they are eligible for reinstatement/regularisation. Since there are sufficient vacancies for these 17 Nos. unless otherwise advice from Public Service Commission, there is no need of creating supernumerary posts.

As per resolution cited above, the Authority resolved to reinstate all physically handicapped employees appointed through Employment Exchange between the period from 15.08.1998 to 15.08.1999 as per Rule 9 (A) (1) of KS&SSR based on the GO(P)No.33/05/SWD dated, 05.03.2005 and GO(P)No.43/07/SWD dated, 09.08.2007.

In the above circumstances, sanction is hereby accorded to reinstate and regularize the following 17 (seventeen) physically handicapped retrenched employees. They are posted to the offices noted against their names with effect from the date of joining duty.
