*Item No. I (1) Confirmation of the Minutes of the 280<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 24/4/2006.*

The Authority confirmed the Minutes of the 280<sup>th</sup> meeting of Kerala Water Authority held on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2006.

*Item No. I (2) Review of action taken on the decision of previous meetings.*

The Authority noted the contents.

*Item No. II (1) Review of billing and collection for the month of March 2006*

The Authority noted the consolidated statement of DCB for the year 2005-06 and observed that urgent steps <sup>have</sup> to be taken for the optimum collection of arrears. It also placed on record its appreciation to all the Divisions which had achieved the target of cent percent or more collection and directed the Managing Director to give <sup>a</sup> letter of appreciation to these divisions and also to Divisions which had achieved a collection target of 80% or more. The Authority also noted that some Divisions had miserably failed to achieve the target given to them. In those cases, the Authority directed the Managing Director to obtain the explanation <sup>was</sup> of the concerned officers of these Divisions whose collection <sup>were</sup> below 65% of the target fixed and to take necessary steps to attain the targeted collection.

The Authority noted the request explained in the Agenda note and directed the Managing Director to take further action as per the rules of Kerala Water Authority.

*Item No. III (1) JBIC Assisted Kerala Water Supply Project – Analysis, design, procurement, supply, installation, testing, commissioning, training and documentation of pilot network of server systems in Thiruvananthapuram*

The Authority noted the contents on this item and directed the Managing Director to place before the Authority the details of the source of funding for the particular project under consideration.

*Item No. III (2) JBIC Assisted Kerala Water Supply Project – Details of negotiated purchase of land and present status of acquisition*

The Authority noted the progress achieved for the acquisition of land at various places for the implementation of the project. It is noted that <sup>an</sup> ~~substantial~~ quantity of land <sup>are</sup> ~~is~~ yet to be taken in possession. The Authority directed the Managing Director to have a close review of the pending issues and closely monitor the progress to ensure the availability of land by the time the contracts are settled. The Authority also stressed that for any loss incurred by Kerala Water Authority due to non-availability of land in time, such loss will be recovered from the concerned <sup>in</sup> ~~the~~ official <sup>of</sup> ~~in~~ the district.

The Authority discussed the item in detail~~s~~ and observed that a comprehensive proposal has to be evolved with fairly clear agreed funding pattern and completion period. The Authority directed the Managing Director to place before it such a proposal after considering all aspects ~~with provisions for making timely expenditure along with adequate fund~~ including availability of funds.
